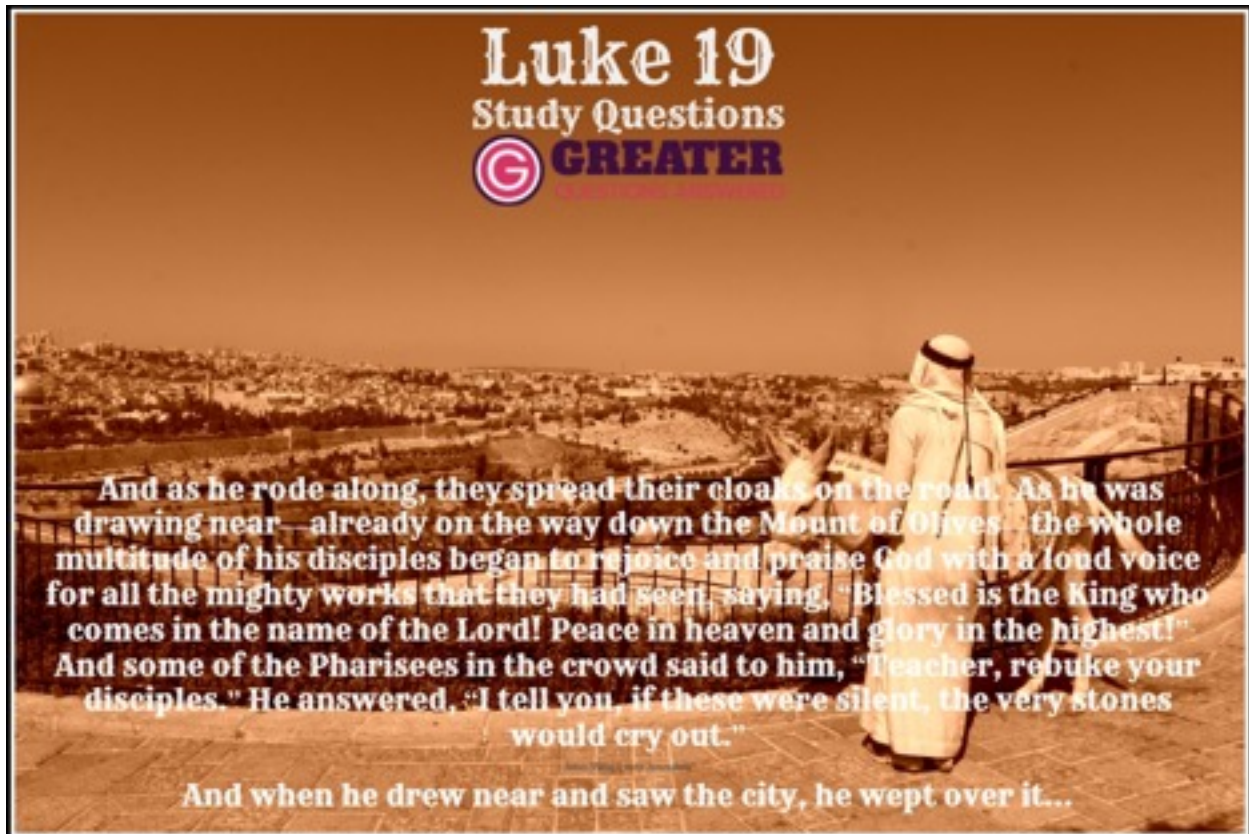
Luke Chapter 18

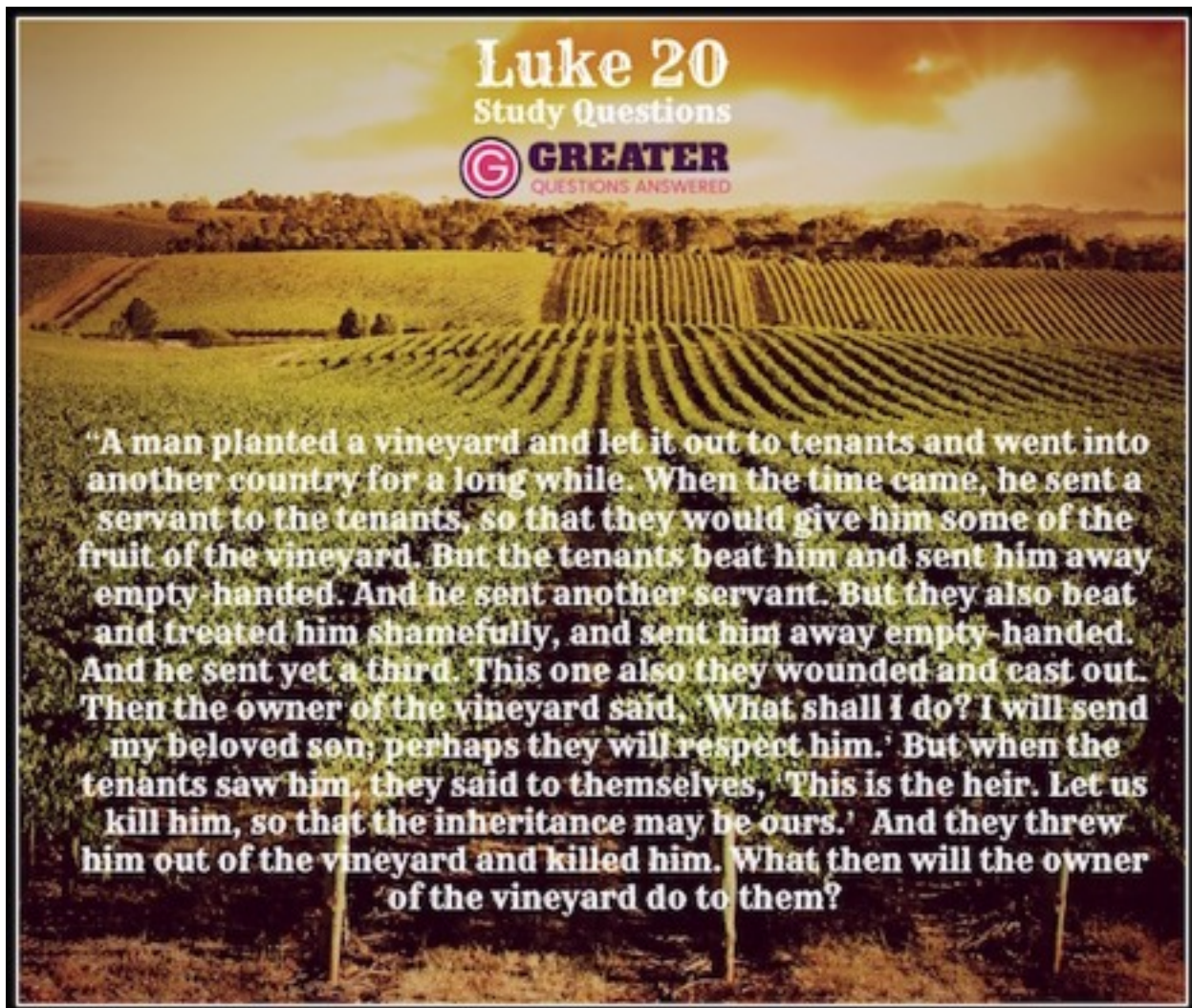
